#### **Performance Notes**

It is intended that *Attunement* be performed by single or multiple voices with the performers' choice of means for realizing the accompanying chords. Each phrase of the text should be sung freely, but not too fast, on one or all of the pitches associated with it. The phrases should be separated from each other by pauses varying from only slight to more lengthy and should be coordinated with the underlying, accompanying chords. *Attunement* may be realized as a sound construction in recording with signal processing, as a live performance, with acoustic or electro-acoustic instruments, or other means determined by the performers. Accidentals apply only to the notes they precede. "—" indicates a pause.
